CLASSROOM SUPPLIES

To ensure equity in the purchasing and distribution of student school supplies, the PTA collects money from families for a schoolwide fund that the teachers use to purchase classroom supplies for every child. Instead of purchasing school supplies individually for your child, please contribute \$40 per child (or whatever you can manage; if you can contribute a bit more to help cover someone else, that is much appreciated!)

WHO DOES WHAT?

The PTA (which is short for Parent Teacher Association) includes the entire parent and teacher/staff community. That means YOU are a member. There are no dues or obligations. The PTA meets monthly to share information, raise questions, discuss and vote on the PTA budget and important issues.

The PTA Executive Board (eBoard) is made up of a group of parents/caregivers who serve as the officers of the PTA. These officers are nominated and voted in by the entire community in an annual election or any necessary special elections. The eBoard meets monthly and works together to fulfill the PTA's mission and goals. Check out the attached document to "meet" the 22-23 eBoard Officers and put faces and names to them.

The Administration Team includes Principal Pilar Ramos and Assistant Principal Meg Crouch.

The School Leadership Team (SLT) includes a group of eBoard, parent, teacher and admin representatives who meet monthly to "develop the school's Comprehensive Educational Plan (CEP) and is responsible for making a yearly evaluation of the principal's record of developing an effective, shared decision-making relationship with the SLT members during the year."
